Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before your transfer to the rail station for a three-hour train ride to the town of Aguas Calientes, followed by a 25-minute motorcoach ascent to "the Lost City of the Incas" for a guided tour of the marvelous citadel. Stroll the archaeological site before enjoying lunch at the Machu Picchu Sanctuary Lodge. Descend by bus to the town of Aguas Calientes to board the train back to Cuzco and your hotel for dinner.

DAY 4: CUZCO/LIMA/SANTIAGO*

You'll be transferred to the airport after breakfast for your flight to Lima. Upon arrival you'll enjoy lunch before your afternoon visit to the Gold Museum, where you'll have the opportunity to admire priceless pre-Columbian gold artifacts. Your tour will end at the airport for your flight to Santiago. Overnight in Santiago.

Interior flash photos are not allowed at Casa Aliaga, Cathedral or Monastery.
