## DINING

**Skyline Main Restaurant:** Located on Deck 5; Inspired by 1930's New York, this Art Deco main restaurant accommodates 628.

**Liberty Main Restaurant:** Located on Deck 6; A classical design depicting some of the most important moments in American history; accommodates 496.

**\*Jefferson's Bistro:** Located on Deck 5; An upscale French restaurant offering a menu of modern and classic gourmet cuisine in a setting modeled from the Georgian residence of Thomas Jefferson; accommodates 78.

**Little Italy:** Located on Deck 11; Contemporary Italian fare served in a fun, bright and relaxed area; accommodates 116.

**\*East Meets West:** Located on Deck 5; A complex that consists of a teppanyaki room, a sushi/sashimi bar and a restaurant; accommodates 84.

**\*Lazy J Texas Steakhouse:** Located on Deck 6; An upscale traditional Texan Ranch-style steakhouse; accommodates 52.

**Cadillac Diner:** Located on Deck 6; Elvis in his heyday on Waikiki Beach. This burger-bar set in the 1950's will feature Cadillac seating, jukebox and televisions and it serves up great food fast; accommodates 106 (70 in, 36 out).

**Aloha Café:** Located on Deck 11; Hawai'i-themed café/buffet; accommodates 680 (370 in, 310 out).

**Hollywood Theatre:** Located on Decks 4 & 5; Main show lounge; accommodates 880.

**The Conservatory:** Located on Deck 11; A quiet area in a tropical setting; accommodates 12.

**Mardi Gras Cabaret Lounge & Night Club:** Located on Deck 6; Fun, New Orleans inspired lounge that functions as the disco in the evening, Karaoke too; accommodates 406.

**Napa Wine Bar:** Located on Deck 6; Full bar specializing in wines by the glass; accommodates 88 (64 in, 24 out).

**Gold Rush Saloon:** Located on Deck 11; Saloon featuring Karaoke, darts and bar billiards; accommodates 125.

**Pink's Champagne & Cigar Bar:** Located on Deck 6; Inspired by Hawai'i's Royal Palace "Pink Palace" Hotel on Waikiki Beach, the bar also includes a cigar lounge; accommodates 104.

**John Adams Coffee Bar:** Located on Deck 5; Serves specialty coffees and delicious pastries; accommodates 61.

**Ocean Drive Bar:** Located on Deck 11; Full bar overlooking the pool area; accommodates 144 (100 seats, 24 bar stools).

**Key West Bar & Grill:** Located on Deck 12; Full bar & grill in a Key West setting; accommodates 114.

**Waikiki Bar:** Located on Deck 13; Full bar inspired by all things "surf"; accommodates 121 (88 seats, 17 bar stools, 16 deck chairs).

**South Beach Pool:** Located on Deck 11; Two main swimming pools; 118 deck chairs.

**Oasis Pool:** Located on Deck 12; Aft swimming pool; 26 deck chairs.

**Hot tubs (4):** Located on Deck 11.

**Santa Fe Spa:** Located on Deck 12; Full service spa decorated with artifacts from New Mexico; accommodates 52+ (15 treatment rooms).

**Santa Fe Fitness Center:** Located on Deck 12; Full gym featuring an aerobic rooms, free weights and cardio machines; accommodates 70+.

**Jogging/Walking Track:** Located on Deck 6; 2.5 laps equal 1 mile.

**Basketball/Volleyball/Tennis Court:** Located on Deck 14

**Golf Driving Net:** Located on Deck 13.

**Outdoor Chess:** Located on Deck 13.

## Public Rooms Cont.

**Life Styles Room:** Located on Deck 6; Room for learning and tutoring; accommodates 13.

**Internet Center:** Part of Library on Deck 6; Laptops for wireless internet connection that can be used throughout the ship.

**Connections Teen Club:** Located on Deck 12; A hip place for teens with dance floor, bar, video juke box, table football & air hockey; accommodates 72.

**Rascals Kid's Club:** Located on Deck 12; Facilities include paddling pool, soft play area, computers, movie room & jungle gym; accommodates 44+.

**Blast Off Video Arcade:** Located on Deck 13; Video and virtual reality games; 50 machines.

**Meeting Rooms & Auditorium Area:** Located on Deck 13; Features 7 meeting rooms (Hawai'i Room, O'ahu Room, Kaua'i Room, Molokai Room, Maui Room, Diamond Head Auditorium & Lanai Bar & Lounge), that can seat anywhere between 10-250; accommodates 606 total (Auditorium 260, Lounge 105, Meeting Rooms 241).
