NCL's organized Shore Excursion program offers you the opportunity to sample the colorful culture and see the most dramatic scenery in each port of call. Pre-arranged sightseeing saves valuable time in port and helps ensure you receive the best services available.

WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Why should I book an organized Shore Excursion?

There are a number of advantages to booking a Shore Excursion organized by Norwegian Cruise Line, including:

We carefully monitor Shore Excursion programs to ensure we are offering the best tours available and meeting the diverse needs and interests of our guests. We use only reputable and licensed independent tour operators.

Convenience

Our organized tours maximize your time ashore and eliminate the need for time-consuming, last minute arrangements in port.

We have a professional and knowledgeable Shore Excursion staff onboard, available to help you expertly plan your time ashore.

Safety

We have developed Shore Excursion programs with primary consideration for your safety and security.

Value

We review our tours continuously to ensure they are of the highest quality and that prices remain competitive.

How does the Shore Excursion program work?

Shore Excursions may be reserved in advance. A request form is provided with this document so that you may finalize your plans well in advance of your cruise. This form must be received by NCL no later than two weeks prior to your sailing date. Do not send payment! Orders will be processed and billed to your onboard account. Shore Excursions are also available for purchase on board. Early in the cruise, the Shore Excursion Manager will present the most up-to-date information on ports and tours. Pick up a Shore Excursion order form at the Shore Excursion Desk. Return the completed form to the Shore Excursion Desk or Drop Box as soon as possible since all requests are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Purchases will be billed to your onboard account. Tickets will be delivered to your stateroom.

Are there any restrictions?

An adult must accompany participants under the age of 18 on all tours. There is no charge for children under the age of 2 who do not occupy a separate seat on a motorcoach tour. Some tours have additional restrictions implemented for your safety. These may include age, weight, height and/or medical history related restrictions. Please refer to the individual tour description for any restrictions or consult with the onboard Shore Excursion staff.

Should I tip the guide/driver?

Tipping is strictly optional; however most tour guides and drivers expect and appreciate a modest gratuity. If food and/or beverages are included as a part of your tour, an additional gratuity for these services is appropriate.

What type of clothing should I wear?

We suggest you wear comfortable walking shoes or sneakers and dress in warm, layered clothing. Due to unpredictable weather it is also advisable to bring along a sweater, windbreaker and/or rain gear, and bring sun protection for tours involving outdoor activities. All tours operate rain or shine! Do not forget your camera and plenty of film!

Will we miss meals?

With Freestyle Cruising, you don't have to worry about missing a meal. Restaurants offer open seating.

What if we miss the ship?

NCL does not leave port until all organized tours have returned to the ship. If you leave an organized tour however, or make tour arrangements on your own, please keep the time in mind and return to the ship at least 30 minutes before sailing.

What if I have made my own flight arrangements - will I be able to purchase airport transfers?

Prior to your cruise, transfers may be purchased through NCL by calling reservations at 1.800.327.7030, or on board during your cruise at the Shore Excursion Desk.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Responsibility

NCL, as a convenience to its guests, may sell tickets for Shore Excursions or arrange other services which are operated by independent contractors not affiliated with NCL. NCL cannot be responsible for the acts or omissions of these independent contractors. NCL's responsibility to guests on board Norwegian Cruise Line vessels is governed by provisions in the Passenger Ticket Contract and does not extend beyond the vessel.

Cancellation or Modification

Cruise schedules are subject to change at the discretion of the Captain, and may occasionally be affected by variations in arrival or departure times, inclement weather, and mechanical or equipment difficulties. NCL reserves the right to change Shore Excursion prices and itineraries without notice. Excursions are subject to cancellation or modification depending on the number of guests participating. NCL reserves the right to cancel a Shore Excursion for any reason, including inclement weather, and shall not be liable for any loss to participants. Participants holding tickets for canceled Shore Excursions will receive a full refund. Should it be necessary to abandon a Shore Excursion due to difficulties en route, NCL will arrange the best possible refund for participants according to the circumstances.

Refunds and Cancellation Fees

All tours cancelled within 24 hours prior to arrival in the port where the tour is scheduled to operate are non-refundable. Certain tours, such as overland tours, customized tours and tours with theater performances or special events may be subject to different cancellation fees. Check with the Shore Excursion Desk for details. You can cancel a tour by returning the tour ticket to the Shore Excursion Desk and advising the staff of the cancellation. Refunds will be credited to the guest's onboard account.

Prices

Prices include meals and refreshments as indicated in the tour description (including gratuities for these services), plus guide and entrance fees, unless otherwise noted. There is no charge for children under the age of two who do not occupy a separate seat on a motorcoach tour. Children's prices are only available as indicated on the order form. Participants under the age of 12 pay child prices and participants 12 years of age and older pay adult prices (unless otherwise noted). Due to weight and balance limitations as well as passenger safety and comfort, helicopter guests weighing 250 pounds (113kg) or more (fully dressed), are charged an additional surcharge to reserve extra space on the helicopter and all flightseeing tours. All prices are in U.S. dollars.

Tour Descriptions, Durations and Departure Times

The tour descriptions are as current and accurate as possible at the time this information is posted on our website. Please note that occasionally changes in the description do occur. Any significant changes will be noted on the NCL website. Some tours will operate in an order that is different from that presented in this document. This helps to alleviate crowding at local venues. The information in this document is designed to help you select the excursions most suited to your interests. The individual tour descriptions include approximate durations and can be found under each tour name. Please note that departure times are subject to change. Please check the NCL website (ncl.com/shorex) for the most current descriptions.

Insurance

The duties and liabilities of a particular tour operator and the scope and extent of the operator's insurance coverage may vary widely, depending upon the country's laws and customs. Because of this, many travel professionals advise their clients to strongly consider purchasing cancellation insurance and a short-term personal health and accident policy from a reputable insurance company before leaving home.

Personal Possessions

Personal articles including cameras, handbags, umbrellas, etc. are the guest's responsibility. NCL does not assume responsibility or liability for any item, or for personal effects, lost or damaged during any Shore Excursion or activity undertaken on behalf of the guest.

Tour Operators

Tour operators have the right to require any individual to withdraw from a tour at any time if they deem the individual's conduct detrimental to or incompatible with the interests, comfort, well-being or harmony of the group as a whole. Tour operators reserve the right to alter or adjust itineraries to meet local conditions for participant safety and convenience. Neither NCL nor local tour operators can extend financial reimbursement to compensate for a participant's disappointment in the event circumstances beyond the reasonable control of NCL or the tour operator make it impossible to provide services as intended.

Transportation

All tours include roundtrip transportation. The best available local transportation is utilized in every port of call. However, guests should recognize that quality standards vary considerably throughout the world. Air-conditioned vehicles are not always available. Cars, vans or taxis are often used in ports where coach transport is limited or not available.

Guests with Disabilities

While NCL strives to make its Shore Excursion program available to all its guests, inherent tour venue limitations and/or tour operator limitations exist that are beyond NCL's control that limit the ability of guests with disabilities to participate in certain Shore Excursions. We urge such guests to advise the Shore Excursion department of disabilities when pre-booking tours and to further meet with the Shore Excursion staff on board to discuss their disabilities as they relate with the unique characteristics of each Shore Excursion. We typically recommend independent transportation for the comfort and convenience of guests with disabilities.

TOUR INDICATORS/SYMBOLS

- Level 1: Tours with this designation involve walking over relatively level terrain. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- Level 2: Tours with this designation can involve a considerable amount of physical activity such as walking over cobblestones or uneven surfaces, climbing stairs or steep terrain, or bicycle riding. They are not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable sturdy shoes are recommended.
- Level 3: Tours with this designation involve physical exertion for extended periods of time. The terrain may be uneven or steep. They are recommended only for the physically fit and adventurous traveler.
- Physically Limited Accommodates guests with limited mobility or in wheelchairs, provided there is a companion to assist them in and out of motorcoaches or other transportation or with the navigation of venues with uneven terrain and/or steps insofar as some or all of the destinations on this tour do not provide special access and/or equipment. Wheelchairs must be collapsible. Please notify the onboard Shore Excursion staff of any special needs or concerns at least 48 hours prior to the requested tour departure.

C-Card: All participants must be certified Scuba divers and must have logged a Scuba dive or completed a refresher course within the past 12 months. You must present a nationally recognized certification card and complete a short medical history and release form at the time of booking. If you are thinking of participating in the Scuba program and have a known medical condition, please get a clearance letter from your physician stating that you have no restrictions to dive. This should be done prior to taking your cruise and the original letter should be brought along with you. Junior Open Water divers between the ages of 10-11 years may dive to a maximum depth of 12 meters, or 40 feet, and must be accompanied by a PADI professional, or an Open Water Certified parent/guardian. Junior Open Water Divers between the ages of 12-14 years may dive to a depth of 18 meters or 60 feet, again accompanied by a PADI professional, or an Open Water Certified parent/guardian. A parent or guardian must accompany any diver under the age of 18.

Meal: This tour includes a meal.

Age Symbol: This tour has specific age requirements.

Weight Symbol: This tour has specific weight requirements.

NOTE: UNDER NCL POLICY ALL PARTICIPANTS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT.

SHORE EXCURSIONS

- ST. GEORGE, BERMUDA -

HERITAGE WALKING TOUR

Approximate Duration: 1 hour

Level 2

The history of Bermuda begins in St. George, the oldest continually inhabited town of English origin in the New World and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Take the opportunity to visit historic buildings and churches, tranquil gardens and quiet alleyways while learning of the town's unique past and Bermuda's early years. Join your local historian guide, certified by the Corporation of St. George, for a personalized and friendly tour, which offers an inside look into life in a small town. Questions are always welcomed.

Note: This is a leisurely one-hour tour with little physical exertion. Comfortable shoes, suntan lotion, a hat and a bottle of water are recommended.

ST. GEORGE CARRIAGE RIDE

Approximate Duration: 1 1/4 hours

This is an informative hour and fifteen minute carriage sightseeing tour of the Old Town of St. George and its beautiful countryside. At the start of the tour you will be given a little history of Sir George Somers and the Deliverance as you make your way through the Old Town of St. George, with a stop at Somers Garden. The tour then continues easterly, providing a magnificent view of St. George Harbor. Further along the tour, you will come upon an old Bermuda cottage, built in the 1780s. At this cottage there will be a detailed explanation on how the people of Bermuda catch the rainwater from the white rooftops. You will be able to get a wonderful view of the narrow channel that led ships into the beautiful St. George Harbor. The tour continues onto the northern coastline, stopping at Buildings Bay, where the famous Deliverance was built. Continuing along the northern coastline, you will pass by a working Bermudian farm before taking in the marvelous scenery and beach available at Fort St. Catherine. As the tour winds down, you will view the ruins of the Unfinished Church and travel through quaint narrow streets such as Governors Alley and Printer's Alley, concluding in King's Square, St. George.

ST. GEORGE PANORAMA & FORT TOUR

Approximate Duration: 2 1/2 hours

Level 2

Get acquainted with the town of St. George and the surrounding area on your pink air-conditioned bus. This tour will take you to some of the most picturesque spots found anywhere. You will visit historic Fort St. Catherine, where only yards away, the survivors of the shipwrecked Sea Venture came ashore in 1609 to start the colonization of Bermuda and where, inside the fort, you will see replicas of Britain's precious Crown Jewels. Your driver/guide will point out many different attractions during your tour and make a photo stop at St. David's Lighthouse, where the views are remarkable. On the return to your ship, your driver/guide will point out Carter House, built around 1640 and believed to be one of the oldest dwellings in Bermuda.

PEPPERCORN HELMET DIVE

Approximate Duration: 2 hours

Level 2, Age

Imagine taking a leisurely stroll on a sandy bottom in less than 20 feet of warm turquoise water, amid spectacular coral reefs with inquisitive tropical fish looking you in the eye and feeding all around. Helmet diving is the safest way to experience Bermuda's fascinating underwater world, and requires no prior swimming experience or training. It is an experience for the entire family. Your helmet is constantly supplied with air and your head stays dry, allowing glasses and contact lenses to be worn throughout the tour. You will be picked up at the ship's pier in your dive boat, which takes you to and from the reef location. Once there, you will be given a comprehensive pre-dive briefing, with particular emphasis on safety and individual tips to help you maximize your helmet dive adventure. Every dive is led by an experienced dive master and assisted by a surface technician.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and must be accompanied by an adult. We do not recommend this tour for anyone with breathing difficulties.

TURTLE BAY CATAMARAN & BEACH TRIP

Approximate Duration: 3 1/2 hours

Lounge around the roomy shaded cockpit of a sailing catamaran, or lie out on one of the huge trampolines and sip complimentary beverages as you cruise by the 80-year-old shipwreck of the Typhin, and century-old remains of Bermuda fortifications. Chat with the crew about Bermuda's past and present as you cruise toward your beautiful private beach in Long Bay. En route you will cruise over the crew's turtle sanctuary. Then the catamaran will anchor in six feet of water, where you may choose to swim up to the nearby beach, lounge on one of the rubber rafts, float on a funky noodle, paddle a kayak, or kick around with the crew's snorkel gear. After an hour-and-a-half of playing in the ocean, you will be welcomed back aboard to indulge in the crew's bottomless barrel of complimentary rum swizzle. Let the island rum and music put you into the vacation spirit as you head out for another hour of true catamaran sailing. The yacht also offers souvenir hats and t-shirts, along with a full cash bar.

Note: This tour is ideal for all age groups, but we do ask that all participants be able to swim. This is a beach site with limited snorkeling, which may be unavailable depending upon weather. Remember to bring your beach towel and sunscreen. Swim locations may vary depending upon weather conditions.

CORAL SEA GLASS-BOTTOM BOAT CRUISE

Approximate Duration: 1 1/2 hours

Level 1

The Coral Sea is a new and elegant glass-bottom boat that is perfect for this information-filled orientation cruise of St. George and the surrounding area. This tour includes three different activities, making it both comprehensive and entertaining. The initial harbor cruise highlights the colorful waterfront homes, harbor islands, and history of the oldest English town in the New World. The second phase of this tour takes you directly to Bermuda's eastern most barrier reef to see first hand the corals and fish that flourish on the world's most northern coral reef. On the way back to the harbor (weather permitting), you will visit a natural habitat of the sea turtle at St. Catherine's Bay, where the hawk's bill and green turtles swim and live on the inner reef.

ST. GEORGE SAIL & SWIM

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Do you want an adventure that is fun and enjoyable? Then this sail tour of Bermuda's oldest part of the island is for you! Captain Jerry, a licensed Captain with over 15 years of experience, will enlighten you on Bermuda's history in vivid detail as you circumnavigate St. George Island onboard a sturdy 41-foot sloop. Relax as you set sail in a casual and friendly atmosphere to a beautiful secluded lagoon where you can snorkel, swim, or just unwind. This is the one tour that is sure to make a splash for all ages!

Note: All equipment and a complimentary soft drink are provided. Pack your towel and sun protection.

OLDE TOWNE RAILWAY TROLLEY TRAIN

Approximate Duration: 1 hour

Level 1

The St. George Olde Railway Train is the best way to see St. George, a World Heritage Site, and appreciate the history of the oldest continually inhabited town of English origin in the New World. You will view the renowned historic sites of the town, including King's Square, as well as explore the back streets and neighborhoods for an extraordinary look at nearly 400 years of history and culture. Your tour begins in the town where Bermuda's unique architecture and historic buildings, including many with strong American connections, will be explored. The route will take you past streets with names such as Duke of York, Kent and Clarence that are a reminder of the town's British connections. Additionally, you will see St. Peter's Church (the oldest Anglican Church in the Western Hemisphere), the Unfinished Church and Somer's Gardens. During the coastal segment of your tour, you will view beaches and pass by important historical sites such as Fort St. Catherine and other forts that protected the island for over 300 years.

ULTIMATE BERMUDA TRIANGLE TOUR

Approximate Duration: 2 hours

Level 1

In just two hours, you will probably learn more about Bermuda than others do during their entire vacation. But don't forget to bring your sense of humor, which is a requirement just to survive this trip! You will board the Argo II, a powerful custom-designed motor trimaran built for passenger comfort and maximum stability for those with 'weak sea legs'. The design allows the boat to pass under low bridges and cruise shallow bays not accessible to many larger boats. Your award-winning Bermudian Captain's comedic storytelling will have you laughing from the moment you depart. The tour begins in historic St. George, a World Heritage Site where you will learn the history of the Old Town as you cruise across the beautiful harbor. The natural beauty of the island and its diversity of plant and wildlife is a particular passion of your Captain, and every opportunity will be given to discuss birds and marine life observed along the way. Depending on the time of year, this could include Bermuda long tails, herons, egrets, mangroves, turtles or shoals of rainbow-colored fish feeding as you pass. Close-up views of magnificent waterfront homes are always a highlight of this tour, and your Captain will make sure you are up to date with the latest real estate prices and the 'who's who' list of Bermuda by the end of the trip. If conditions permit, you will visit Bermuda's most exclusive neighborhood of Tuckers Town, where real estate begins around \$10 million and culminates in Billionaires Row, where you will see the homes of some of the world's wealthiest people, including the waterfront estates of Ross Perot and New York Mayor Michael Bloomberg. On the return trip your Captain will explain some of the secrets of the infamous Bermuda Triangle. The Ultimate Bermuda Triangle Tour is designed to be highly interactive and you are encouraged to enter into lively discussion about the people, politics and any other aspect of Bermuda life that is of particular interest to you. The tour is small and friendly and we guarantee you lots of laughs along the way.

Note: Exact tour content may vary to accommodate prevailing conditions on the day. Cold beverages are available for sale on board and the boat is 70% shaded.

ST. GEORGE GLASS-BOTTOM ECO KAYAK

Approximate Duration: 2 hours

Level 2, Weight

Your brand-new glass-bottom kayak is a fantastic way to view the beautiful underwater world of corals and fish. Not only will you be able to see the reefs and fish clearly, you will feel safe and secure as your special kayak is extremely stable, easy to handle and dry. There are no other kayaks like this anywhere else in Bermuda! After boarding your kayak either from a beach in waist-deep water or the boat, you will be instructed on how to kayak. The group will then paddle along beautiful shorelines made up of lagoons and fascinating rock formations at a relaxed pace for approximately one hour. Along the way you will usually see herons, Bermuda long tails and other different types of birds, depending on the time of the season. As you paddle, quite often the water is calm and clear enough to see colorful coral reef and fish. You will go past some of Bermuda's forts dating back to the 1600s, and your Bermudian tour guide will provide you with information all about the island's endemic flora, history and marine eco-system. The tour ends with a choice of a cooling swim or relaxation on the boat.

Note: Kayaks are two-seaters and have a weight limit of 400 lbs. Kayaking is approximately 45 minutes. Complimentary bottled water and a safety vest are provided. All sites are excellent and the tour will go to the best site depending on weather conditions. Wear a bathing suit and bring a towel!

THE EXOTIC SWIM TOUR

Approximate Duration: 2 1/2 hours

Level 2

All you need is a towel, a swimsuit and a great sense of humor to experience a few hours with the 'locals' at one of their favorite swimming holes! Let us take you to one of Bermuda's most secluded spots for a swim in tranquil turquoise waters in quiet coves and bays that only the locals know about. You will board the Argo II, a custom-designed trimaran, for a leisurely sightseeing motor cruise to one of our carefully selected swimming sites away from the crowds and very close to nature. A sense of humor is essential to your survival as your award-winning Bermudian skipper regales you with fascinating tales about the island and the people who live here. Audience participation will take on a whole new meaning when you take this tour. Along the way, we will cross the beautiful St. George harbor and pass magnificent Bermuda homes, nature reserves and bird sanctuaries while learning about life in this tiny island paradise. Swim time varies depending on the site we choose on the day, but is never less than 45 minutes. When we arrive at our chosen swim site, we will usually be able to anchor the boat in about five feet of protected water, where most adults can stand. Of course, if swimming sounds a little too energetic you can simply relax on the boat, listen to some soothing music or float in the shallows with a noodle and enjoy some of Bermuda's most idyllic scenery. The Exotic Swim Tour is your chance to enjoy a very private corner of Bermuda. Each tour is fully narrated by your host, who is dedicated to making your adventure the most unique and memorable part of your holiday in Bermuda.

Note: Cold beverages are available for sale on board and the boat is 70% shaded. This tour is suitable for all age groups but the ability to use a boat ladder is required. Basic flotation aids are available but we do not recommend this tour to non-swimmers.

Level 1, Physically Limited

Welcome aboard for a relaxing evening on the 60-foot catamaran Sundeck as you slowly cruise along the shoreline, enjoying views of Bermuda's spectacular pastel homes and colorful landside. You will venture into little bays and out onto the north shore in time to view one of the most exquisite sunsets in the world! During your journey, your crew will serve you complimentary rum swizzles, the best in Bermuda! So come aboard, relax and enjoy a wonderful evening on Bermudas beautiful waters. The tour ends back in St. George Square, allowing you to enjoy Market Nights, a local street festival with wonderful arts, crafts, jewelry, food and entertainment.

Note: A full cash bar is available with the best happy hour prices on the water. This tour is great for everyone including wheelchair passengers!

SUNSET GLASS-BOTTOM COCKTAIL CRUISE

Approximate Duration: 1 1/4 hours

This relaxed cruise has great viewing of the fish and coral through a specially lit glass-bottom boat. The trip includes an open bar with soft drinks, beers, wines and highballs (included in the price), and offers views of the sunset from many different angles. Bermudians have been building glass-bottom boats for over a hundred years, and the Coral Sea is the newest of these specialized vessels to be built on the island. The knowledgeable crew explains the many differences between the daytime and nocturnal reef dwellers as you enjoy the soft light of this romantic, early evening interlude.

No swimming ability needed and you can wear glasses or contact lenses under your helmet. Wet suits and hot drinks are provided when the water temperature is below 80 degrees. Cold sodas are available in summer months. Each dive is approximately 30 minutes long with 6 or 7 people per dive. There is a large shaded area, air-conditioned cabin, sun deck, full bathroom and changing room with shower on board.

DOLPHIN DIP

Approximate Duration: 1/2 hour

Level 2, Age

The Dolphin Dip is a half hour in total, which includes an introduction and 25 minutes of dolphin time in a combination of both shallow-water and deep-water interaction. Half the time is spent sitting about waist-high on a submerged platform, where the dolphins come right up to your lap and where you will have a lot of hands-on interaction with them. The other half of the program takes place in the deeper water, where you observe the dolphins swimming under and around you, having a chance to see them through a mask and experience more interaction with them. Swimming is done on the surface of the water - there is no underwater diving involved. The depth of the water may vary from 12-20 feet, depending on the tides.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and be able to get in and out of the water without assistance. Lifejackets are required throughout the duration of the program. It is not recommended for pregnant women to participate in a dolphin swim program. Water shoes are suggested.

THE EZ RIDER ELECTRIC BIKE 'N HIKE TOUR

Approximate Duration: 2 3/4 hours

Level 2

Tour Bermuda on an easy to pedal, seven-speed, electric mountain bicycle. Join EZ Rider on an electric pedal-assisted bicycle and sightseeing tour through the picturesque West End. You must pedal to make it go, but as you pedal an electric motor assists you. When you stop pedaling the motor stops assisting you, and your ped-elec bike coasts and stops just like a bicycle. You will depart from the Royal Naval Dockyard, then ride over lazy country roads, through quiet neighborhoods and the historic Railway Trail.
